For more than 25 years, she has worked with children, teens, families, educators and clinicians to improve communication and foster deeper relationships.

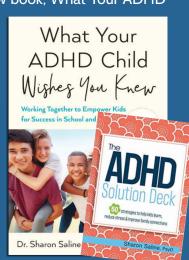
